With a continuous desire to serve, each IPS fire team member currently serves on a municipal fire department during their days off — keeping our community safe!



IPS offers on-site fire services including equipment and personnel with two full-time fire fighters at the instructor level making it easy to meet client requirements or even individual one-off requests.
